

## **SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

**THIS Agreement** made this the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2007, by and between 1<sup>st</sup> Connection Mortgage Inc., a licensee under the Mississippi Mortgage Consumer Protection Law (Section 81-18-1, Miss. Code Ann. 1972, *et seq.*) (hereinafter referred to as Licensee) and the Mississippi Department of Banking and Consumer Finance (hereinafter referred to as DBCF).

**WHEREAS**, DBCF received information reflecting an advertisement of Licensee in violation of Section 81-18-31(c)(e), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated;

**WHEREAS**, Licensee has decided that he does not desire to contest the findings and violations cited against the Licensee by the Department and does not desire to request a public hearing on the matter, and instead desires to fully and finally settle this matter with DBCF without a public hearing on the terms and conditions set forth herein; and,

**WHEREAS**, Licensee understands that this Settlement Agreement has the same force and effect as an Order of the DBCF entered after a public hearing, that this Settlement Agreement is a public record, and that this Settlement Agreement and the civil money penalties imposed herein will be published on the website maintained by DBCF wherein the official acts and orders of DBCF are posted;

**NOW THEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED**, Licensee hereby agrees to pay a civil money penalty in the total amount of \$250.00 to DBCF.
