
Dear Ms. Miller:

This letter is pursuant to previous certified correspondence mailed to your attention on June 27, 2007. The previous correspondence was a Notice of Revocation letter concerning three (3) unpaid judgments found in the Justice Court of Lowndes County in favor of Plaintiff, Christine Richards, each in the amount of Four Hundred Four Dollars (\$404.00), on March 2, 2005, for a total of One Thousand Two Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$1,212.00). As stated in the previous letter from Geoffrey Morgan, your failure to pay these judgments within thirty (30) days is a violation of Section 81-18-37(1)(b), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated. This letter stated that you had thirty (30) days within the date of notice to request, in writing, a hearing on this matter. As of the date of this letter, this written request has not been received from the company. The Department may revoke any license, per Section 81-18-37(2), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, for a violation(s) of Section 81-18-37(1)(b), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated.

Therefore, this letter shall serve as notice that license #462/2006 issued on behalf of Family Mortgage Co, Inc, located at 2650 Livingston Road in Jackson, Mississippi, is hereby revoked as of the date of this letter. Please return the original company license and the original three (3) Loan Originator registrations (Edward L. Cole, Firmist J. Alexander, Jr., Vickie L. Miller) that are currently assigned to Family Mortgage Co, Inc. In addition, the Department's recourse in order to ensure payment of the judgment of One Thousand Two Hundred Twelve Dollars (\$1,212.00) in favor of Christine Richards is to call the bond with the Department on behalf of Family Mortgage Co, Inc. The amount requested from the bond will be the total judgment amount, and will also include a civil money penalty for violation of Section 81-18-37(1)(b), Mississippi Code of 1972, Annotated, in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) payable to the Department.
